Described as the "White Dove of the Desert", this mission is located nine miles south of downtown Tucson. Father Eusebio Francisco Kino founded the Mission in 1692. The present church was built under the direction of Father Juan Bautista Velderrain and Father Juan Bautista Llorenz (Franciscans). It required 14 years of intermittent labor from 1783-1797. It has been acclaimed as the finest example of mission architecture in the U.S.A.

Items for sale include Tohono O'odham baskets, jewelry and arts and crafts from various Native American tribes.

This world famous Observatory sits on top of the 6,875 feet high Kitt Peak in the Quinlin Mountains. The Observatory was founded in 1958 and is home to over twenty-five research telescopes which make it the world's largest working observatory. The facility is managed by the National Optical Astronomy Observatories for the National Science Foundation.

- There are paid and free tours available daily; evening stargazing programs by reservation only
- The gift shop features a variety of Tohono O'odham baskets and crafts
- No services on the mountain; however, there is a picnic area with water and restrooms

The San Xavier Cooperative Association is a group of individual landowners who continue to farm at San Xavier and formed an association in 1971. By 2008, the Farm will have expanded its operations to 960 acres and will offer a diversity of organically grown crops.

The Farm is committed to the growing and reintroduction of traditional O'odham crops as well as non-traditional vegetables and hay products. The Farm grows all its products chemical-free, which support the cultural and environmental values of the San Xavier Community.

Traditional crops that are grown are tepary beans, 60-day O'odham corn, Pima wheat, a variety of squash and melons and O'odham peas. Other products are devil's claw, gourds and a natural honey. Hay products include alfalfa, oats and Bermuda grass-mix.
