February Notes: Organ Pipe NM used estimates for some traffic counters. Petrified Forest NP is undergoing road related construction projects through March which includes closing five miles of roadway, requiring alternate routes and some double counting of visitor vehicles along with contractor traffic. North entrance traffic counter no functioning accurately. Pipe Spring NM used estimates due to broken counters. Sunset Crater NM visitor center was closed Feb. 2-29 for new exhibit installation.
