### **DATA DEFINITIONS**

Travel Spending: The sum of visitor and travel spending in Arizona.

Employment: Industry employment (jobs) supported by travel spending.

Tax Revenue: The state tax revenue generated by travel spending.

Hotel Occupancy: The percent of available rooms that are occupied in a given

time period. (Supply/Demand)

YOY: Year-over-year comparison. The top section provides August

2020 data compared to August 2019. The Year-To-Date section

provides Jan.-Aug. 2020 data compared to the same time in 2019.

PP: Percentage points. The difference of two percentages.

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
