January Notes: January 20th was a NPS fee free day (Martin Luther King Birthday). Numerous parks were affected by the Federal Government Shutdown January 1-26, 2019. Coronado NM reported construction related increases in counts. The Hubbell Trading Post NHS Visitor Center was closed on Mondays and Tuesdays due to staffing issues. Navajo NM traffic counters are not functioning. Organ Pipe NM used estimates for some traffic counters. Petrified Forest NP is undergoing road related construction projects through March which includes closing five miles of roadway, requiring alternate routes and some double counting of visitor vehicles along with contractor traffic. Tonto NM resumed tours on 1/17/20 that were suspended due to the Woodbury fire.
