June Notes: Navajo NM remained closed to the public in June however seasonal staff in the office did record visitors on site. Organ Pipe Cactus NM, Petrified Forest NP and Wupatki NM reported using estimates for some locations. Sunset Crater NM, which is adjacent to the Coconino National Forest, noted that a forest closure on 6/23/21 included campgrounds and trails in the area. Tonto NM closed the lower trail for 8.5 days due to excessive heat warnings. The Lake Mead NRA visitor count representing the AZ portion for 2021 is estimated.
