May Notes: The Lake Mead NRA visitor counts representing the AZ portion for 2021 and 2022 are estimated. In 2022, Glen Canyon NRA reported that while most launch ramps continued to be closed due to the low lake level Wahweap and Bullfrog ramps opened with ramp extensions. Hubbell Trading Post NHS limited indoor capacity but hosted outdoor events. The North Rim opened May 15th at Grand Canyon NP. Sunset Crater Volcano NM was closed due to wildfire impacts. Wupatki NM was closed for nine days due to the Pipeline Fire. Coronado NM, Saguaro NP and Tuzigoot NM reported traffic counter issues.
