July Notes: The Lake Mead NRA visitor counts representing the AZ portion are estimated. The visitor center at Chiricahua NM and Fort Bowie NHS were only open Sunday and Monday. At Grand Canyon NP, wildland fire on the North Rim resulted in numerous closures including inner canyon trails. Lake Mead NRA and Saguaro NP reported traffic counter related estimates. The Petrified Forest NP visitor center was closed for construction requiring the use of estimates. Tonto NM was closed on July 17 and reported heat related trail closures on four days.
